She is an Associate Professor of Bocconi University in Milan.

She has had experience in research positions and lectureships in the United States and in France. She has carried out research on various strategic topics, especially in the management and enhancement of artistic patrimony and cultural heritage. She was previously a Director of the ASK (Art, Science and Knowledge) research centre of Bocconi University and of the degree course in Economics for the Arts, Culture and Communication (CLEACC).

She is the author of numerous articles in national and international publications.

She is currently a Director of Egea S.p.A., Fondazione Arnoldo e Alberto Mondadori and Lombardia Film Commission. She is also Chairman of the valuation committee for the selection of the general coordinator of the Foundation for Cultural Assets and Activities and Tourism.
